#### costumes

- The student's name should be on all costume pieces, tights, shoes and accessories.
- When transporting costumes, they must be placed in a garment bag. All accessories should be in a dance bag. Student's name should be on both the garment bag and dance bag.
- Costumes are not to be worn publicly before the recital. When the costume is brought home, it should be hung up and put away until pictures.
- No underwear are worn under costumes.
- Students who need bras should wear appropriate bras with their costumes.

#### shoes

- Capezio tap shoes ages 3-8 are caramel. No bows or ties. Should be secured with tan elastic or buckles, if the shoes are not Velcro or have an attached buckle.
- Capezio tap shoes ages 9-11 are caramel. They should be an intermediate heel that buckles unless otherwise specified by teacher.
- Tap shoes 12 and over will be specified by teacher for their class.
- Capezio "Daisy" pink ballet shoes for the younger students. They should be properly sized for the concert no gapping or extra room at toes. Strings should be tied and must be tucked in. If necessary cut string after tying if too long.
- Cecchetti Grades III & IV wear Capezio canvas Juliet ballet shoes.
- Jazz students wear Capezio split sole caramel jazz boot, unless otherwise specified by teacher.

#### hair

- All hair is to be securely fastened away from face in a braided "BUN" at the back of the head (not on top of the head). The only exception to the bun will be if the teacher wants a specific style for the class. Students in multiple numbers, will have "same" hairstyle throughout the entire performance.
- There are no "BANGS" on stage as they create a shadow across the face.

## face & make-up

- No eyeglasses on stage. If the student absolutely cannot see, please notify the teacher prior to the rehearsal and show.
- All students should wear a foundation regardless of age. Without foundation, the face appears flat with splotches of color. Mineral powders

- are exceptional for a foundation and are all natural. They can be applied lightly or heavily depending on the amount of coverage you want.
- Everyone's skin tone (undertone) is different. To say a whole class will use pink blush, blue eye shadow does not work. Coral is a universal color and looks good on all skin tones. Try to select a blush and lipstick that has a coral base. In selecting eye shadow look for neutral tones. Lighter for the younger students; richer and more dramatic for the older students. Each class will be addressed in regard to their make-up needs.
- Students ages 3-7: light foundation, minimal eye shadow, blush, lipstick, mascara.
- Students ages 8-10: foundation, <u>eyeliner</u>, eye shadow, blush, lipstick, mascara.
- Students ages 11-13: foundation, eyeliner, eye shadow, blush, lipstick, mascara, and false eyelashes.
- Students ages 14+: full face = foundation, eyeliner, eye shadow, blush, lipliner, lipstick, mascara, false eyelashes.

# general information

#### STUDIO RUN-THROUGHS & DRESS REHEARSALS

- ✓ Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your scheduled time for the studio runthroughs.
- ✓ Please wear regular dance class attire, no costumes for the studio runthroughs.
- ✓ <u>DRESS REHEARSAL is CLOSED to the public</u>. Siblings and other family members are not invited.
- ✓ Dress rehearsal will start promptly at 9:45 AM and 12:15 PM.
- ✓ Please arrive 1 hour prior to the start of dress rehearsal.
- ✓ Costumes should not be worn from home to the performance venue.
- ✓ Costumes and stage make-up should be worn for dress rehearsals.
- ✓ Students are permitted to sit in the theater to watch dress rehearsal.
- ✓ All participating students must be in the auditorium 15 minutes prior to the start of dress rehearsal.

#### **PERFORMANCES**

- ✓ The day performance will start promptly at 3:00 PM and the night performance at 6:45 PM.
- ✓ Arrive 1 hour prior to performance times.
- ✓ Costumes should not be worn from home to the performance venue.
- ✓ Costumes and stage make-up should be worn for performances.
- ✓ The first 5 numbers need to be backstage at 15 minutes before the start of the show.
- √ Younger classes will have two designated mothers to help line-up, bring the students back stage, take children to the bathroom, etc. The stage mothers are NOT babysitters. Each parent/guardian dresses and gets her

own child ready. When the child is done performing the child is pickedup by their parent/guardian. Only the designated stage mothers are allowed backstage.

- √ No gum on stage at any time.
- ✓ No street shoes on stage at any time (hip hop shoes should not be street shoes).
- √ No jewelry is permitted on stage unless specified by teacher.
- ✓ Please remove all nail polish; fingers and toes.
- ✓ General etiquette for attending a performance is that the audience remains seated. Do not enter or exit the theater while students are performing on stage. Parents with young children and must get up, please sit in the back of the theater.
- ✓ Faculty and stage mothers are the only individuals permitted backstage.
- ✓ Mothers are permitted in the dressing rooms to assist with costume changes.
- ✓ Friends, family and siblings are not permitted in the dressing rooms
- ✓ Students need to be lined up back stage 5 numbers before they perform.
- ✓ Students who wish to watch the performances must have a ticket.
- ✓ Students watching the performance may not wear their costumes in the theater.
- √ Following performances, no one is permitted on the stage.
- √ No helium filled balloons are permitted in the facility due to the sprinkler system!
- ✓ NO PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO DURING DRESS REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES you will be asked to leave if you are caught!
- ✓ Hoffer's Video Production will film the performances (please see included form).
- $\checkmark$  Picture information is included in this packet a photographer will be at the studio 5/31, 6/1 and 6/3 (please see included schedule for class picture times).
- ✓ 2017-2018 Registration Forms are included in the packet All students registered for the 2017-2018 year and September tuition paid by May 24<sup>th</sup> will receive a 10% discount off of their total bill.
